



The Season

- Registration opens in January and closes after the final Tryout
- Teams are formed in late February and parents should be contacted by the Coach in early March
- Optional practices held the week of spring break with regular practices beginning the following week
- Games schedules developed in March with games beginning in early April and continuing through May
- Postseason begins in June with the Tournament of Champions featuring the top Minors and Majors teams in the District
- All Star teams are formed in June with District & State tournaments continuing through July

Gear / Uniforms

- The League provides each team with bats, helmets, balls, catcher equipment, and First Aid Kits
- The League provides each team with uniforms. This is accomplished through a partnership with the <u>AZ Diamondbacks</u> and by purchasing from local vendors.
- At a minimum, parents should be prepared to provide a glove and cleats for their player. Additional gear may be purchased such as a bag, batting gloves, helmet, catcher equipment or a bat.
 - o If you purchase a new bat, Little League has a specific standard for bats that can be used. Please refer to the USA Baseball Performance Standard for details.

Tryout / Skills Assessment

- This event allows the League and Coaches the opportunity to assess player development and provides the evaluation needed to accomplish the draft process for the Majors & Juniors Divisions
- The League requires that players League Age 10-14 attend this event.
 - o For Baseball: players born on or before August 31, 2014
 - o For Softball: players born on or before December 31, 2013
- The goal of this assessment is to help the League assign players appropriately between the Minors,
 Majors & Juniors Divisions.



Eligibility

Little League rules require that player eligibility must be established either by residency or school enrollment



SCHOOL ATTENDANCE SHALL BE ESTABLISHED AND SUPPORTED BY:

A document indicating enrollment for the current academic year, dated prior to October 1 of previous year, and with the physical location of the school from **ONE of the following categories:**

- The School Enrollment Form provided by Little League (LittleLeague.org/SchoolEnrollmentForm)
- Official/Certified enrollment record, confirming current enrollment, that includes the school's physical address and the original signature of the school's senior administrator (principal, headmaster, etc.)

NOTE: A school-issued report card/performance record will no longer be accepted to establish school attendance.









Once Assigned to a Team

- Complete, sign and turn in the Medical Release Form to the Coach
- Complete, sign and turn in the Code of Conduct to the Coach
