

PVLL Coach Code of Conduct

Each Manager and Coach must review & sign prior to the beginning of the season.

I will provide support and encouragement for all participants of PVLL by following this Code of Conduct.

1. I will hold a parent meeting to set expectations. I will establish a communication plan to keep the families up to date on team activities.
2. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, managers, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or event.
3. I will insist on good sportsmanship between my players and with how my players treat their opponents. Trash talking by my players will not be tolerated at any PVLL or Inter-league games.
4. I will place the emotional and physical well being of the children ahead of my personal desire to win.
5. I will insist that the participants play in a safe and healthy environment.
6. I will provide support to the managers, coaches and officials working with the players to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
7. I will demand a positive environment for the children that is free from drugs, alcohol, tobacco and foul language. I will refrain from the use of these things at all PVLL events.
8. I will remember that the game is for the children and not for the adults
9. I will do my best to make PVLL fun for the players.
10. I will ask my team to treat other players, managers, coaches, officials and fans with respect.
11. I will enforce respect for Town of Prescott Valley Parks by not allowing climbing on fences, swinging on gates, throwing rocks or vandalism of any kind.
12. I will honor my commitment as a coach to be on time and prepared for practices, games and other PVLL events.
13. I understand that disrespect towards an umpire or official will not be tolerated and will result in ejection from the game and other penalties as imposed by the Board of Directors.
