- 5. I will demand a positive environment for the children that is free from drugs, alcohol, tobacco and foul language. I will refrain from the use of these things at all PVLL events.
- 6. I will remember that the game is for the children and not for the adults
- 7. I will do my best to make youth sports fun, for the players, parents, and others.
- 8. I will require my player to treat other players, managers, coaches, officials, fans with respect.
- 9. I will help teach respect for Town of Prescott Valley Parks by not allowing climbing on fences, swinging on gates, throwing rocks or vandalizing restrooms.
